The trailer will first be put to use for a local, philanthropic venture. As part of its business philosophy, Break the Chain gives back to organizations that address the social issues they tackle. Break the Chain is putting out a “Fill the Trailer” challenge to Santiam Canyon area businesses. They are asking businesses to collect new or gently used items such as clothing for teenagers, sheets, kitchenware and cleaning supplies for which to fill their new trailer. A wish list of donations is included below; donations may be delivered or scheduled for pick-up.

The goal is to have the trailer filled by end of business day Friday, April 17th. Break the Chain is scheduled to deliver this trailer filled with donations to the Canyon Crisis Center, 475 NE Santiam Hwy in Mill City, at 11 a.m. on **Saturday, April 18th**.

The Canyon Crisis Center serves the communities of Idanha, Detroit, Gates, Mill City, Lyons, Mehama, Elkhorn, Stayton, Sublimity, Aumsville, Scio and Lebanon. This Crisis Center provides support groups for victim issues and empowerment, emergency gas vouchers/transportation, safe house referrals, family mediation and victim intervention. They have a 24-hour crisis intervention hotline.
